² Compass is taken by grade 10 students who are not yet academically ready for a career or college based on their growth in academic achievement between grades 8 and 10 (as determined by performance on the grade 8 Reading and Mathematics MCA and grade 10 PLAN).

Once open, grade 10 Compass is available after PLAN results are received and is available throughout the school year except during ACT testing.
